


Budget & Staffing

The Sheriff's Office is the primary law enforcement agency in the county. Our other responsibilities include transporting inmates/prisoners to and from jails, prisons and our courts; serving court documents and writs to county residents; staffing the courts with security personnel when court is in session; and dispatching all calls for emergency services (Sheriff, State Police, Fire, Rescue, Animal Control, Conservation Police, etc.) in Goochland.

The Auditors have broken down the Office budget into four categories: Sheriff-Court Related, Sheriff, Emergency Services (Dispatch), and Correction and Detention (the per diem fee paid to Henrico County Jail and James River Juvenile Detention for the keeping of adult and juvenile inmates).

The Sheriff's Office is funded by both the State and the County. In addition, The Sheriff's Office used asset forfeiture funds to purchase equipment and a new police dog "Chase" that will begin active duty with us in May 2015. The office also received several grants to purchase equipment and to use for traffic enforcement.

One of the philosophies of the Sheriff's Office is to ensure that we can carry out our mission despite our small size. We cross train our deputies to perform all of the functions of the agency. Many of our deputies have specialties, but all are involved with the day to day activities of the office. Five of our deputies started as dispatchers, and occasionally, they help out in the Communications Center when there is a manpower shortage. Three of our deputies are trained in hostage/crisis negotiations; eight volunteer to be a part of our Tactical Rescue Team. Two investigators are trained to analyze computer components and digital media on our F.R.E.D. (Forensic Recovery Electronic Device) computer and the Cellubrite system.


In addition, we have many deputies who have other specialties (canine, language interpretation, firearms instruction, etc.)



Hundreds of county citizens have attended the Citizen's Academy which has been in existence since 1993. The academy which meets annually and (sometimes semi-annually) introduces students to the many aspects of law enforcement operations in Goochland. Classes include a jail tour, forensic nurses, state police, the commonwealth's attorney, dog demonstrations, and fire and rescue operations. The program culminates with a ride-along with a deputy.

January 7: **Sheriff Named to Governor's Task Force on Mental Health**

In the aftermath of the stabbing of Senator Creigh Deeds and the subsequent suicide of his mentally ill son, Governor McDonnell named Sheriff Agnew to the Task Force. Governor McAuliffe continued the appointment after he took office.

Goochland has made two substantive changes in the way we deal with mentally ill people in crisis situations:

- 1) In partnership with West Creek Emergency Center and The Goochland Community Services Board, sheriff's deputies now transport people in need of mental health evaluations to the West Creek Hospital. In this setting, which is less intimidating than the sheriff's office, patients now have quicker access to medical treatment, a necessary component of the commitment process.
- 2) The agency is now working to train all uniformed deputies in CIT (Crisis Intervention Training). As of December 31, Sheriff Agnew and deputies Bock, May, East, Maupin, Carrier, Forman, J Henley, Donithan, Wood, Murat, SN Creasey, and Cranor have attended. Four more deputies should complete the training by the end of 2015.



February 6: The Murder of Reserve Police Captain Kevin Quick

In the early afternoon of February 6, the body of Kevin Quick, a reserve police captain in the Waynesboro Police Department was found in a remote area of southwestern Goochland by State Police, the FBI and a sheriff's deputy from Fluvanna. Captain Quick had been abducted days before in Charlottesville as he pulled into a parking lot during what was supposed to be a visit with his girlfriend and infant daughter.

Several members of a central Virginia "Bloods" gang were later arrested by Virginia State Police for his abduction and murder. Originally arrested on state charges in Goochland, they will be tried in 2015 in US District Court in Charlottesville after the US Attorney for Western Virginia adopted the charges. Four people, Daniel Mathis, Shantai Shelton, Mersadies Shelton, and Travis Bell were charged with Quick's murder. Five additional individuals were charged in connection with his abduction and murder.

April 30: **Security Assessment of Goochland Schools**

As a follow up to a visit from Virginia's Public Safety Secretary, Bryan Rhode, in December, 2013, an assessment team of county public safety and school officials began site visits to all Goochland Schools. The assessment team concluded its visits with an evaluation of the Goochland High School/Goochland Middle School complex on April 30.

Assistant Superintendent Peter Gretz, school maintenance supervisor Sonny Turner, and Goochland Fire Chief Bill Mackay joined Sheriff Agnew and Deputy Chris Cranor as they, assessed the security of all three elementary schools, and the high school and middle school complex.

The assessment team reviewed physical security, visitor protocols, lighting, parking and traffic flow, emergency procedures, storage of potentially hazardous materials, and communications procedures at each site.

The team made a number of recommendations to improve the safety of students, teachers, visitors, and first responders. The results were compiled and turned over to the School Board.

Aug 28: Treasurer's Distress Warrant

While most residents are conscientious about keeping property and business taxes up-to-date, some are not. One of the duties of a sheriff is to execute documents issued by courts or treasurers to force neglectful taxpayers to pay delinquent taxes or judgments recorded in the courts. On August 28, County Treasurer Pam Johnson accompanied four deputies as they levied on equipment belonging to a business in the eastern end of the county. According to the treasurer's records, the business owed in excess of \$130,000 in back taxes.

Deputies spent most of the day levying and seizing more than 25 vehicles and trailers to satisfy the judgment. As a result, the treasurer was able to work out a payment plan to recover the money owed to Goochland County.

§ 58.1-3941. What may be distrained for taxes.

Any goods or chattels, money and bank notes in the county, city or town belonging to the person or estate assessed with taxes, levies or other charges collected by the treasurer may be distrained therefor by the treasurer, sheriff, constable or collector. Property subject to levy or distress for taxes shall be liable to levy or distress in the hands of any person for taxes, penalties and interest thereon, except that any highway vehicle as defined herein purchased by a bona fide purchaser for value shall not be liable to levy or distress for such taxes unless the purchaser knew at the time of purchase that the taxes had been specifically assessed against such vehicle.

September 30: **Anthony White Indicted for Heroin Trafficking**

An investigation led by Lieutenant Chuck Henley resulted in numerous charges against Anthony E. White, 50, of Goochland. White was indicted by the multi-jurisdictional grand jury after months' of testimony by Henley and witnesses subpoenaed before the panel.

This case was unique as it was the first time that a person in Goochland has been charged as a result of a "historical" investigation. The case was built through interviews, surveillance, phone records, bank records and subpoenas issued through the grand jury. No undercover informants, officers, or buy money was used in this case.

The grand jury returned 10 indictments for distribution of heroin against White. His sentencing was scheduled for April, 2015.



November 20: **Deputy Carrier Is Deputy of the Year**

The Dewitt Clinton Masonic Lodge named Deputy Matt Carrier as Goochland Deputy of the year during an award ceremony at the lodge. Carrier was recognized for his exemplary patience in dealing with a person suffering a mental health crisis on August 14. The man, who suffers from schizophrenia, had run out of his house with a large knife threatening to kill anyone who came near him.

Deputies arrived shortly thereafter at which time the man ran into the woods. When he reappeared he walked towards the deputies and threatened to kill them with the knife. At one point, the man grabbed his pet dog by the hind leg and said he was going to stab it in the stomach.

Fortunately, Deputy Carrier finally established a rapport with the man, and after numerous threats by the obviously distressed man, Carrier talked him into dropping the knife and he was taken safely into custody and later transported to the hospital to receive treatment for his illness.

Community Concerns

Speeding

Speeding complaints from residents constituted one of the most vocalized concerns in 2014. New subdivisions, Short Pump Town Center traffic, and a shift in driving habits from I 64 to Routes 250 and 6 for East/West traffic accounted for many of the complaints.

Deputies set up selective enforcement efforts on 250, 6, Fairground Road, and a number of other county roads to attempt to slow traffic. The office also deployed the RADAR trailer to advise motorists of their speed.

Civil Problems

As the county has grown, we have noticed an increase in disputes and disagreements among neighbors. Those that cannot be resolved are often referred to deputies who act as de facto mediators. Goochland deputies do not take action in civil disputes unless ordered to do so by a court. Consequently, deputies do not get involved in any enforcement actions regarding rights of way, breach of contract, child custody, marital or communal property or other complaints that are not codified as criminal.

Deputies responded to 76 calls classified as a civil issue.

Noise

Goochland County does not have a noise ordinance. Classifying sounds as noise without a measurable standard is totally subjective and unconstitutional according to the courts. Nevertheless, deputies responded to 106 noise complaints and 47 shooting complaints from residents. Most of those complaints were mitigated by the deputies.


Suspicious Persons 2014

By Hour of the Day




All Calls for Service to Dispatch 2011-2014




Calls for Service for Sheriff 2011-2014




Sheriff Calls by Day of Week 2014




Fire/Rescue Calls by Day of Week 2014




Sheriff Calls by Hour of Day 2014



Fire/Rescue Calls by Hour of Day 2014







Law Enforcement Beats




Fire Districts (Stations)











JDR, Circuit and General District Criminal courts are staffed by a minimum of 2 deputies whose sole responsibilities are court security and prisoner management.

Persons entering JDR and General District Criminal Courts are required to pass through a metal detector and X-ray screening machine operated by 2 court security specialists:





Deputies are responsible for moving inmates/prisoners to and from jails across the state for appearances in our courts and for commitments to mental hospitals. The most frequently visited jails are Henrico (Goochland is a partner with Henrico in a regional jail), Richmond, Chesterfield, James River Detention Center, Riverside Regional Jail, and Piedmont Regional Jail. In 2014, deputies transported prisoners to and from jails as far away as Norfolk and Wise County.



The Sheriff's Office is also responsible for evictions and judgment collections when ordered to do so by the court. In addition, deputies serve papers for courts from around the state. These include jury summonses, subpoenas and writs. The office conducts background checks for citizens applying for Concealed Handgun Permits and fingerprints Goochland citizens who need fingerprint cards for employment.


