

Goochland County Electoral Board

DRAFT Minutes 4/10/2018

The Goochland County Electoral Board convened at 6:55 pm in the General Registrar's conference room. Present: Chair Keith Flannagan, Vice Chair Wanda Taylor, Secretary Robin Lind, Director of Elections/ General Registrar Winston Forrest, Deputy General Registrar Kendall Hutchinson.

Representing the public: Buddy Bishop, Marjorie Duerreberry, Larry Eggleston, John Myers, Charlotte Whitmire.

On a motion by the vice chair, seconded by the chair, the board unanimously approved the minutes for 3/6/18 as submitted.

Officers' Reports:

The Secretary reported briefly on legislation and the GREB WorkGroup which was scheduled to meet on Wednesday.

On a motion by the secretary, seconded by the chair, the board voted unanimously to table the scheduled closed session Review of the Security Plan until the end of the meeting.

Discussion ensued on the roster of Officers of Election including those who had retired, those who had returned their oaths, those who might be promoted and new officers who had recently completed their applications for appointment. The DoE was asked to provide a revised list for review on April 17.

On a motion by the secretary, seconded by the vice chair, the board voted unanimously to appoint the officers as presented to a one-year term.

The chair then invited comment from the members of the public. General discussion ensued on the performance of the DoE, the general operations of the office, the preparations for the upcoming dual primary and training.

On a motion by the secretary, seconded by the vice chair, the board voted unanimously to acknowledge the Writ of Election issued by the Circuit Court on March 27 calling for a Special Election on November 6, to coincide with the General Election, to fill the vacancy caused by the death of Supervisor Ned Creasy. It is hereby included in these minutes.

Discussion ensued on the Bar Code scanners acquired by the DoE and a brief demonstration was given to members of the public who were able to present a driver's license to the scanner which, when scanned, immediately brought up the correct identity on the attached Electronic Poll Book. The scanners are to be put into service at the dual primary in June.

At 8:10 pm, the Vice Chair being required elsewhere, the secretary moved to table the remaining agenda until April 17 and adjourn; the vice chair seconded the motion which was adopted unanimously.
