

Goochland County Electoral Board
Minutes June 1, 2020

The Goochland County Electoral Board convened at 6 pm in the Registrar's office. Present: Vice Chair Wanda Taylor, Secretary Robin Lind, and Director of Elections/General Registrar Ryan Mulligan. Chair Keith Flanagan attended by telephone and asked the vice chair to chair the meeting.

On a motion by the chair, seconded by the secretary, the minutes for the May 19 meeting were unanimously approved as submitted.

The director of elections reported on the absentee ballots returned and discussion then ensued on assignment of Officers of Election at the several precincts. In view of the threat to specific groups from the pandemic virus, he board agreed that furloughs would be granted to officers for the upcoming primary on June 23 on account of age or compromised immune systems.

The director of elections reported that VERIS has accepted the emergency polling place change in Blair Precinct from Collegiate Athletic facility to St. James's Church. He also discussed a letter from a USPS Postal inspector regarding postage on Absentee ballots; the secretary, supported by the board, directed him to forward the letter to his ELECT liaison for review and counsel.

Discussion ensued on plexiglass shields being made by the County's Dept of General Services which are to be delivered to precincts with the cages.

Discussion also ensued on upcoming calendar dates and the need to have a firm commitment from the county on complete sanitizing of polling places following the election.

At the close of the meeting the director of elections distributed the annual performance review form which will be completed individually by board members and combined at their next regular meeting to comply with §24.2-09.1

There being no further business, on a motion by the secretary, seconded by the chair, the board voted unanimously to adjourn at 7:10 pm.
