

Goochland County Electoral Board
Omnibus Minutes October-November, 2021

The Goochland County Electoral Board met on multiple occasions in preparation for the November election, and following to ascertain Results including:

- Officer of Election Training, conducted by individual members on October 20 and
- Logic & Accuracy Training of Voting Machines on October 19 and 20
- Chiefs and Assistants Training October 28
- Electronic Poll Book programming October 31
- Circuit riding to inspect polling places on Election Day, November 2, 2021

The board met at 6:07 pm on October 12, Present Vice Chari Wanda Taylor, Secretary Robin Lind and Director of Elections Ryan Mulligan

The Secretary, describing his diminished vision, asked the director of elections to take the minutes,

Discussion ensued on officer of election recruitment and deployment. The secretary reported on the Election Integrity presentation he and the director of elections gave to the board of supervisors on October 5.

At 6:31 the board was joined by Chari Keith Flannagan who had been delayed.

Discussion then ensued on In-Person Absentee voting and the director of elections explained that on on occasion lines had forms and voters took 30 minutes to cast ballots after the VERIS software system crashed in Richmond.

Discussion ensued on upcoming training sessions. The Board recessed at 7:07 pm

The board reconvened at 9 am on November 3 to canvass results. Present Chair Keith Flannagan, Vice Chair Wanda Taylor, Secretary Robin Li

At 12:26 pm the board recessed until 12 pm Friday November 5

At 12:15 pm November 5 the board reconvened to consider provisional ballots.


Hadensville: Three ballots rejected

Provisionals completed at 2:05 pm the board stood at east awaiting the completion of the final CAP totals.

After the Central Absentee Precinct completed their tallies, the board reconvened to complete its canvass.
