

Goochland County Electoral Board
Minutes December 13, 2022

The Goochland County Electoral Board was called to order at 9:42am. Present: Chair Pamela Johnson, Vice Chair Robin Lind, Secretary Wanda Taylor, Chief Deputy Registrar Shannon Grayson and there was no one present from the public.

On a motion by the Vice Chair, seconded by the Secretary, the minutes of November 9, 2022 meeting were approved as printed with correction.

The Chief Deputy Registrar submitted the latest voter registration counts. There are 20,814 active voters in the county. The board reviewed the registration count by locality and the 662 inactive count. The Chief Deputy Registrar also stated that at the completion of redistricting process precinct 402-Centerville grew to 3334 registered voters and it is still growing.

The Chief Deputy Registrar presented the Electoral Board with seven names for approval as Officers of Elections. The Vice Chair moved that the Board accept the names as presented by the Chief Deputy Registrar subject to being found fit and approval by the Precinct Chief and the General Registrar. The Secretary seconded the motion. Approved unanimously.

Unfinish business:

- The Chief Deputy Registrar announced that the Hotwash will be on Thursday December 15th in the Kitchen of the Administration Building at 6pm.

New Business:

- The Chair recognized the Director of Elections for the excellent record keeping and advice concerning the processing of felony voter registration.
- The Chair also suggested a meeting be scheduled with both parties to discuss the activities of poll workers vs the responsibilities of an officer of elections.
- The Chair stated that she will work with the secretary to identify the calendar days for next year election season, officer training and Electoral Board election activities and meetings.

Officer reports:

- Secretary – informed the board that the work group will be coming to an end and will make their final recommendation in January.
- Vice Chair – spoke about the Freedom of Information Act that is being proposed by David Bovenizer to allow FOIA request to be put aside during the early voting period.
- Chair – Thanks Robin Randolph Lind for his impeccable service on behalf of the Electoral Board members and the citizens of Goochland for his service and assistance for 20 years.

Robin Lind commented that he is leaving the board in Very Good hands.

The next meeting will be Monday January 9, 2023 at 6pm.

There being no further business, on a motion by the Chair and seconded by the Vice Chair the board voted unanimously to adjourned at 10:45am.
