

Goochland County Electoral Board
Minutes March 6, 2024

The Goochland County Electoral Board was called to order at 10:14am. Present: Chair Pamela Johnson, Vice Chair Bob Walker, Secretary Wanda Taylor, Director of Elections /General Registrar Ryan Mulligan. Also present was Goochland resident Jennifer Strozier.

Citizen Comments: There were none.

On a motion by Vice Chair seconded by the Secretary the board went into close session at 10:16am pursuant to State Code Section §2.2-3711 and §24.2-653: to process provisional ballots. Motion carried.

The Electoral Board return to open session at 11:11am. On a motion by the Chair and seconded by the Secretary to certify that only public business matters lawfully exempt from open meeting requirements by Virginia Law, and only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed session were heard, discussed, or considered.

The Director of Elections/General Registrar reported that the Fire Station will not have a recreation facility, therefore Avery Point will become a polling place. It was suggested that they leave the gate up on election day.

On a motion by the Vice Chair, seconded by the Secretary the Electoral Board decided to ask the Precinct Chief to return to make any corrections. Motion carried.
