Goochland County Electoral Board  
Minutes January 8, 2024

The Goochland County Electoral Board was called to order at 6:01pm. Present: Chair Pamela Johnson, Vice Chair Bob Walker, Secretary Wanda Taylor, Director of Elections/General Registrar Ryan Mulligan. Also present was Goochland resident Jennifer Strozier

Citizen Comments: There were none.

On a motion by the Vice Chair, seconded by the Secretary, the minutes of December 11, 2023, meeting were approved as printed with correction.

On a motion by the Vice Chair, seconded by the Secretary, the slate of 2024 Electoral Board officers will be Chair – Pamela Johnson, Vice Chair – Bob Walker and Secretary – Wanda Taylor. Motion carried.

*Report of the Director of Elections/General Registrar:*

*1. Registration Counts.*

- a. The Chief Deputy Registrar submitted the latest voter registration counts. There are 21, 794 active voters in the county. The board reviewed the registration count by locality. The Director of Elections/General Registrar also stated that precinct 402-Centerville has reached 4005 registered voters which means that two DS200 are required for the Presidential election.
- b. 402 – Centerville precinct will be split into two precincts using two different entrances to St. Matthew church. The Secretary will contact Donna Coffee to confirm arrangements.

*2. Appointment of Officers:* It was decided to vote on officers of elections at the next meeting.

*3. Update concerning additional polling places:* the Director of Elections/General Registrar stated that he will be meeting with Tara on 1/9/2024 to discuss new precinct.

Unfinished Business:

- The Electoral Board reviewed the 2024 Calendar. A motion was made by the Secretary, seconded by the Vice Chair to accept the dates for the 2024 calendar with correction. Motion carried.
- L&A testing per policy adoption will be Bob Walker. The Director of Elections/General Registrar stated that he is still waiting for the election material and have pushed L&A out to 1/11/2024. He will notify party chair of the dates.
- Other: The Chair raised the question to the Electoral Board of the possibility of canceling Sunday voting. There were some discussions, but no decision was made to make the change.

New Business:

- The Electoral Board discussed the impact of reducing the timed for early voting.

Officer reports:

- There were no reports.

There being no further business, on a motion by the Chair and seconded by the Vice Chair the board voted unanimously to adjourned at 7.34pm.
