

Goochland County Electoral Board Minutes June 19th-24th, 2024

The Goochland County Electoral Board was called to order at 10:17am on Wednesday June 19th, 2024. Present: Chair Pamela Johnson, Vice Chair Bob Walker, Secretary Wanda Taylor, Director of Elections /General Registrar Ryan Mulligan. Also present was Goochland residents Susan Lascolette and an authorized candidate representative Teemu Garity.

On a motion by the Vice Chair, seconded by the Secretary the board went into session at 10:17am on Wednesday June 19th, 2024, to review Provisionals pursuant to §2.2-653.01 certifying the proceedings to determine validity. The Director of Elections/General Registrar gave the board permission to open envelope 1A for all precincts.

- There was a total of 15 provisional ballots, 2 VBM – Vote by Mail and 13 SDR – Same Day Registrations
- It was determined that final processing of all SDR – same Day Registration provisional ballots will be on Monday June 24th, 2024.

The board recessed the provisional meeting at 11:12am to reconvene on Monday June 24th at noon in room 270 on a motion by the Vice Chair and Seconded by the Secretary.

The board reconvened on Thursday June 20th at 12:15pm for canvass. Present: Chair Pamela Johnson, Vice Chair Bob Walker, Secretary Wanda Taylor, Director of Elections /General Registrar Ryan Mulligan. Also present was Goochland residents Susan Lascolette and an authorized candidate representative Teemu Garity.

- The board reviewed the precincts election results for accuracy and if applicable the chiefs were notified and returned to make the necessary corrections.
- The board recessed the canvass meeting a 1:53pm to reconvene on Monday June 24th at noon in room 270 on a motion by the Vice Chair and Seconded by the Secretary.

The board reconvened on Monday June 24th at 12:12pm to finalized review of Provisionals and election results. Present: Chair Pamela Johnson, Vice Chair Bob Walker, Secretary Wanda Taylor, Director of Elections /General Registrar Ryan Mulligan. Also present was Goochland residents Susan Lascolette and an authorized candidate representative Teemu Garity.

The Board returned to Public Session at 12:48pm, on a motion was made by the Secretary and seconded by the Vice Chair to certify that only public business matters lawfully exempt from open meeting requirements by Virginia Law, and only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed session were heard, discussed, or considered.

- On a motion by the Secretary, seconded by the Vice Chair the board approved the following provisional
 - 102-1D, 301-1R, 302-1R, 401-1R, 402-1R, 402-2R, 402-4R, 402-5R, 402-6R, 501-1R, 502-1R, EV-1D, EV-1R, EV-2R
- On a motion by the Secretary, seconded by the Vice Chair the board denied provisional 402-3R.

There being no further business, on a motion by the Secretary and seconded by the Chair the board voted unanimously to adjourned at 2:51pm.
