

Goochland County Electoral Board  
Minutes June 21<sup>st</sup>, 2025

The Goochland County Electoral Board was called to order on June 21<sup>st</sup> at 10:00am in General Registrar Office instead of room 270 of the County Administration Building. Present: Chair Bob Walker, Vice Chair Pam Johnson, Secretary Wanda Taylor, Director of Elections /General Registrar Ryan Mulligan.

No citizens were present

The Goochland County Electoral Board reconvened provisional meeting at 10:10am pursuant to State Code Section §2.2-3711 and §24.2-653

Five precincts had provisional

- All twelve Provisionals were reviewed and approved for 301-Beaverdam, 302-Randolph, 403-West Creek, 501 – Manakin and 502-Blair.

The ballot box was opened, confirmed empty and sealed. A total of 12 ballots were casted. Provisional meeting closed at 11:28am.

The board resumed canvass at 1:14pm

On a motion by Vice Chair seconded by the Secretary the board went into close session at 2:20pm pursuant to State Code Section §2.2-3711(1)(34) for discussion, consideration, or interviews of prospective candidates for employment, assignment, appointment, promotion, performance, demotion, salaries, disciplining, or resignation of specific public officers, appointees, or employees of a public body. Discussion on consideration by the State Board of Elections or local electoral boards of personnel matters made confidential pursuant §24.2.625.1. The motion carried.

- The Board returned to Public Session at 3:30pm, a motion was made by the Secretary and seconded by the Vice Chair to certify that only public business matters lawfully exempt from open meeting

requirements by Virginia Law, and only such public business matters as were identified in the motion convening the closed session were heard, discussed, or considered.

- The Electoral Board met with the Director of Elections/General Registrar to discuss and complete the yearly performance review. The Electoral Board overwhelmingly thanked the Director of Elections/General Registrar for all his hard work in the successful completion of the past election session, in addition to his growth in management and knowledge.

The board closed canvass at 3:55pm and with no further business, on a motion by the Chair and seconded by the Vice Chair the board voted unanimously to adjourned at 3:59pm.
