PUBLIC FACILITIES

Central High Cultural and Educational Complex (CHS)

2748 Dogtown Road, Goochland, VA 23063

The Central High Cultural and Education Complex consists of the Cultural Arts Center, Athletics and Activities Center, and the Agricultural Center.

Cultural Arts Center includes a 170-seat multi-use auditorium, five classrooms for programs, a training room, and Central's very own museum and conference space. The Complex also boasts multiple historic exhibits and an interactive kiosk that allows visitors to learn about the facility's history.

Located at the rear of the complex, the Athletics and Activities Center includes a 14,000-square-foot gymnasium, a large multi-use room, and a warming kitchen. The facility can be converted into a large-scale events space with carpeted floor coverings, state-of-the-art sound, and multi-use seating.

The Agricultural Center is a 6,800-square-foot facility adjacent to the Cultural Arts Center. The facility is home to the Goochland County Extension Office and the Monacan Soil and Water Conservation District. The center includes lab space, a demonstration and programming kitchen, and interactive exhibits highlighting the agricultural resources and services of Goochland County.

The outdoor spaces of the Central Complex include a 1/4-mile walking track, nature trail, one multi-use field, two lighted softball fields, and demonstration spaces for the Agricultural Center.

Goochland Court House Green & Trails (CGC)

2938 River Road West, Goochland, VA 23063

The Courthouse Green includes a historical restoration of the old stone jail, interpretive signage, and a visitor's center. The "Green" is widely considered to house the most well-preserved Jeffersonian Court House in Virginia. The Old Stone Jail (c. 1825) renovation, completed in September 2016, features exhibits highlighting law enforcement and prison life in Goochland. Exhibits cover multiple eras from 1825 to the 1950s. The Courthouse Green Welcome Center once served as the Circuit Court clerk's office. A colonial-style trail encircles the green and allows visitors to learn about Goochland's courthouse through interpretive signage.


Courthouse Trails is a 55-acre parcel of densely wooded and hilly terrain located behind the Goochland County Courthouse Complex. The 2-mile trail system will be a soft surface multi-use trail featuring scenic views, natural water features and areas to enjoy the natural environment. The trails can be accessed adjacent to the Goochland County Annex Building in the Courthouse Complex.

Goochland Sports Complex (GSC)

1800 Sandy Hook Road, Goochland, VA 23063

The Goochland Sports Complex is an 8-acre facility consisting of several athletic amenities. The GSC exterior facilities include a fully irrigated and lighted football and baseball field complete with grass infield. The Complex also includes a lighted softball field, scoreboards, football and baseball press boxes, public address system, concession stand with restrooms and the County's only public skateboard park - Skate 522.

The interior Goochland Sports Complex facilities are home to the Recreation Division's administrative offices as well as dance studio, cardio room, weight room, classroom, a full sized gymnasium with hardwood floors.



Hidden Rock Park (HRP)

1920 Hidden Rock Lane, Maidens, VA 23102

Hidden Rock Park is a 60-acre facility that serves as home to Goochland Youth Athletic Association's baseball and softball programs. The northern portion of the facility contains two youth baseball fields and two full-sized baseball/softball fields. All of these fields are lighted. In addition, Hidden Rock has nature trails, two picnic shelters, nine-basket disk golf course, a concession stand with public restrooms, public address systems, an asphalt basketball court, covered and lighted batting cages, and a volleyball court. It also contains the Hidden Rock Bark Dog Park, built in partnership with Goochland Pet Lovers, that connects to the Goochland County Animal Shelter and Adoption Center via a trail system.

Leakes Mill Park (LMP)

3951 River Road West, Goochland, VA 23063

Leakes Mill Park is a 176-acre facility located approximately three miles west of the Goochland Courthouse area. The park features three fully irrigated multi-use Bermuda athletic fields, a concession/restroom facility, two picnic shelters, and a large playground. The park also features nine miles of multi-use trails with ten unique bridge crossings and access to the park's namesake, Leakes Mill.

Matthews Park (MP)

5399 Matthews Road, Goochland, VA 23063

Matthews Park is a 36 acre community park located in the western end of Goochland County. The park features a playground, swings, picnic area, and a walking trail.

Reynolds Recreation Complex (RRC)

1851 Dickinson Road, Goochland, VA 23063

A 5-acre facility located on the Reynolds Community College- Goochland Campus maintained and operated by Parks and Recreation, the facility includes a partially-lit baseball/softball field and 3 fully-lit tennis courts. Tennis court lights are operational through the use of a coin operated lighting system.

Tucker Park at Maidens Crossing (TP)

1300 Maidens Road, Maidens, VA 23102

Tucker Park at Maidens Crossing is a 36-acre facility located along 1,200 feet of the James River. The park is home to many amenities that provide a quality experience along the river. Tucker Park features a playground, a non-motorized boat ramp, a one-mile walking/exercise trail, interpretive signage, and the CarMax Cares Outdoor Amphitheater. The amphitheater is capable of hosting large-scale outdoor events along the riverfront and includes electricity, overflow parking, and a lined sycamore grove. It also contains the Tucker Bark Dog Park, built in partnership with Goochland Pet Lovers. A pedestrian crossing beneath the Rte. 522 bridge connects the eastern and western sides of the facility.
