

# Lifting a Boil Water Advisory

## Boil Water Advisory to Consumers of Goochland Courthouse Water System LIFTED

---

As of February 20, 2026, the Boil Water Advisory has been lifted for homes in the Goochland Courthouse Water System in Goochland County.

The Boil Water Advisory was issued on February 17, 2026 after service interruption and loss of water pressure to customers located on Gathright Drive and Scott Road within the Goochland Courthouse Water System in Goochland County.

A series of bacteriological samples were collected and sent to a state certified lab. All samples collected on February 18, 2026 and February 19, 2026 were absent of both total coliform and *E. coli* bacteria in the area where the Boil Water Advisory is currently being lifted.

Following flushing the service line and premise plumbing, residents can safely resume normal use of their tap water.
