Personal Property Taxes

DUE JUNE 5TH AND DECEMBER 5TH OF EACH YEAR

Personal Property taxes are billed twice a year. One half of the annual tax is due on June 5th, and the second half is due on December 5th. (If June 5th or December 5th fall on a weekend, the due date is the following Monday.)

A 10% penalty for late payment is applied the first day after the due date. The penalty is on the original assessment (before the PPTRA discount is applied). PPTRA is the Personal Property Tax Relief Act, passed by the State Legislature. The State pays this portion of the taxes due.

Interest for late payment begins to accrue at the rate of 10% per annum beginning July 1 and January 1 after the tax due dates.

Goochland County prorates the personal property tax on motor vehicles, trailers and semitrailers. These properties are taxed for the portion of the year that the personal property is legally located in Goochland County. The legal location of a motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer is defined as the place where property is normally kept or garaged.

Mobile homes, boats and boat motors, business equipment and machinery and tools are not prorated.

If you do not receive your bill(s), please contact the Treasurer's Office at (804) 556-5806 BEFORE the due date. Failure to receive your bill does not relieve you of additional charges that accrue for failure to pay by the due date.
