

# 2020 Summer Camp

Goochland County Parks & Recreation is happy to announce the following camp line up for the 2020 season. Due to the COVID-19 pandemic, there will be multiple changes to this camp season. Please see the back of this flyer, or contact the department for more information.

All camps will be held at the Central High Cultural and Educational Complex Gym Building (2748 Dogtown Road, Goochland, VA 23063). Due to social distancing and capacity requirements, there will only be 20 spaces available each week. Camp will run 9am – 3pm. Before and after care is available from 7:30am—6pm for an extra fee.

### ***Important Summer Camp Changes***

Goochland County Parks and Recreation plans to begin summer camp on Monday, June 29<sup>th</sup>. The following changes have been made to ensure proper sanitation and social distancing:

#### ***Sign in and out procedures***

- Parents will utilize the drop off/pick up loops and stay in their vehicle—P&R Staff will not buckle children into car seats, that is the responsibility of the parent.
- Parents will receive a stylus to sign in and out on an iPad.
- Temperature checks will be required each day prior to the child exiting the vehicle. **Any child with a temperature above 99.5 will not be permitted to attend camp.**
- Campers will wash hands or use hand sanitizer prior to joining their camp.
- All campers, staff, and instructors will be required to wear masks during the camp day, unless exempt.

#### ***Location***

- Camp will be held at the **Central High Cultural and Educational Complex (2748 Dogtown Road Goochland, VA 23063)** with a maximum of 20 participants per week.

#### ***Changes during the camp day***

- Increased hand-washing will be required.
- Camp numbers will be limited to ensure social distancing (max 20 kids per week).
- Staff will be performing more frequent cleanings throughout the day.

#### ***If there is a confirmed or suspected case***

- Parents/guardians will be notified immediately via email and phone call (infected child will not be identified).
- The infected site will be closed for 2-5 days to ensure a deep cleaning.
- Camps will resume as soon as it is deemed safe.

#### ***Sanitation Standards***

- High traffic areas, rooms used for camps, and door handles will be sanitized each day prior to opening.
- Additional cleanings will be performed every hour or as needed.
- Hand sanitizer will be available for staff and camper use.
