

A project spearheaded by the Goochland County Historical Society and supported by Goochland Parks and Recreation, this facility features a historical restoration of the old stone jail (c. 1825), interpretive signage, and a visitor’s center. The “Green” is widely considered to be the most well-maintained and preserved Jeffersonian Court House in America.

The old stone jail restoration, completed in September 2016, features multiple exhibits that highlight law enforcement and prison life in Goochland County. Exhibits cover multiple eras from 1825 to the 1950s.





Goochland Powhatan Master Gardener Class of 2021

Now is the time to complete your application for an opportunity to gain in-depth knowledge about gardening and give back to your community. All applications for the Goochland Powhatan Master Gardener training program for 2021 must be turned in by November 1, 2020. The program offers more than 50 hours of instruction on a broad range of horticultural topics including garden flowers, ornamental trees and shrubs, insect/plant disease identification, weed management, soils and plant nutrition, vegetable gardening, home fruit production, lawn care, and water conservation. All classes are taught by Virginia Tech extension specialists, agents, and local experts. In exchange for training, participants are asked to volunteer time to their County Extension program with at least 50 hours of volunteer service within one year following the training to earn their certification as a Master Gardener.

The type of service done by Master Gardeners varies according to community needs, and the abilities and interests of the Master Gardeners. Some Master Gardeners answer telephone requests for information related to gardening while others staff plant clinics or displays at community events. They may help establish community garden projects, work with 4-H youth, or assist their agent with press releases related to gardening. The Master Gardener coordinator in the County Extension office decides how volunteer time can be best utilized. Tuition for the training class is \$140 (cash or check). Limited scholarships are available. Applications can be acquired online at gpmga.org or by calling the Goochland Extension Office at 804-556-5841 or the Powhatan Extension Office at 804-598-5640.

Leash Law

Goochland County's leash law runs from April 1 through May 31. All dogs must be tied, penned or under the owner's immediate control (the owner must be with the dog). All dogs must be on a leash when on Goochland County Property throughout the year. If you have any questions regarding the leash law, please contact Goochland Animal Protection at 804-556-5302.

Lifetime Dog Licenses

Lifetime Dog Licenses are now available for purchase at the Treasurer's Office. The Lifetime Dog License eliminates the need for citizens to re-register the same dog every year. Once purchased, the Lifetime Dog License remains valid so long as the dog's rabies vaccination is current and the dog and owner live in Goochland County. Cost of the tags will be \$10.00. The Lifetime Dog License is only valid for the dog for whom it was issued.

The Lifetime Dog Licenses apply only to single dogs. There is no reduced cost for neutered or spayed animals. There is no change in multi-dog licensing. Multi-dog licenses of 20 for \$25.00 and 50 for \$50.00 are still available and must be purchased annually.



Projects at Tucker Park spearheaded by the Friends of Goochland Parks include a one-mile track, a 35-space handicapped accessible parking lot, a non-motorized canoe/kayak launch ramp, and construction of the CarMax Cares performance stage (funded by a grant from the CarMax Foundation).

Most recently, the Friends of Goochland Parks used funds received from a Dominion Foundation grant to launch a community-wide environmental sustainability initiative, featuring events such as Autumn River Day and Goochland Green Day.
