AT A MEETING OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF GOOCHLAND, VIRGINIA, HELD ON MARCH 15, 2022, IN THE GOOCHLAND COUNTY ADMINISTRATION BUILDING, 1800 SANDY HOOK RD., SUITE 250, GOOCHLAND, VIRGINIA, THE FOLLOWING ACTION WAS TAKEN:

Ordinance repealing Goochland County Code, Chapter 2 (Administration), Article II (Board of Supervisors; School Boards; Elections) and adopting new Sections 2-26 through 2-85 relating to revisions to the Electoral Map, Election Districts, Voting Precincts, and Polling Places after the 2020 U.S. Census, and School Board Elections

WHEREAS, Virginia Code §§ 15.2-1427 and 15.2-1433 enable a local governing body to adopt, amend, and codify ordinances or portions thereof; and

WHEREAS, Article VII, Section 5 of the Virginia Constitution and Virginia Code § 24.2-304.1 require localities to redistrict every ten years, coinciding with the decennial U.S. Census; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the 2020 U.S. Census, adjustment of the County’s election district and precinct boundaries is necessary; and

WHEREAS, the County posted a proposed redistricting map on its website on December 17, 2021, and notified the public of the opportunity to comment; and

WHEREAS, the County solicited public comment on the map from December 17, 2021 through February 1, 2022, through its redistricting website, through a dedicated email address and dedicated phone line, and at seven community meetings, each of which included a 35-minute presentation of the map and supporting data, and each of which allowed residents to comment in-person or virtually; and

WHEREAS, the proposed map, opportunity for public comment, dedicated email address, dedicated phone line, and community meetings were publicized to county residents through press releases, social media, and advertisements in the Goochland Gazette; and

WHEREAS, the County has complied with the Virginia Voting Rights Act, Virginia Code § 24.2-129(B) and (C); and

WHEREAS, a summary of the public comments and requests for three revisions to the proposed redistricting map were presented to the Board of Supervisors at a public meeting held on February 22, 2022 at 6:00 p.m., but the Board of Supervisors voted not to make any revisions to the proposed redistricting map; and

WHEREAS, in consideration of the Board’s desire to provide for substantially equal population among its election districts, to establish compact and contiguous districts, to facilitate participation by all citizens in the election process, to minimize voter disruption and confusion, to retain the same basic shape of the current districts, and to provide for the effective administration of elections by drawing appropriate precinct boundaries and designating accessible public polling places, the Board has determined that this ordinance amendment should be made; and

WHEREAS, the full text of this proposed ordinance amendment was available for public inspection in the Goochland County Administrator’s Office, County Administration Building, 1800 Sandy Hook Road, Goochland, Virginia 23063; and

WHEREAS, after proper advertisement was made as required by law, a public hearing was conducted on March 15, 2022, at the Goochland County Administration Building, Board Meeting Room 250, 1800 Sandy Hook Road, Goochland, Virginia 23063.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, that the Goochland County Code is hereby amended, and this ordinance is hereby enacted as follows:

1. Chapter 2 (Administration), Article II (Board of Supervisors; School Boards; Elections) of the Goochland County Code is repealed in its entirety.

~~As used in this article, "official electoral map of the county" means the map attached to the ordinance of August 6, 2019, kept on file by the clerk to the county board of supervisors, which shows the election districts and precincts in the county.~~

~~Pursuant to authority contained in Code of Virginia, §§ 15.2-1211, 24.2-305, as amended, the election districts of the county are hereby created and established as set forth in this division.~~

~~Sec. 2-43. Descriptions.~~

~~The election districts of the county shall be numbered 1 through 5, with population and description set forth as follows:~~

~~(1) — *Election District No. 1* (population 4,347). Commencing at a point where Newline Road (State Highway Route No. 619) intersects with the Goochland boundary with Louisa County west of Gum Spring; thence southward along the centerline of Newline Road (State Highway Route No. 619) to a point of intersection with Three Chopt Road (State Highway Route No. 700); thence in a easterly direction along the centerline of Three Chopt Road (State Highway Route No. 700) for approximately 1,800 feet to the eastern boundary of Census Block 4004001010; thence following in a southerly direction along the eastern boundaries of Census Blocks Nos. 4004001010 and 4004001055 to the point of intersection with Broad Street Road (U.S. Highway Route No. 250) and Cooley Road (State Highway Route No. 705); thence along the centerline of Cooley road in a southerly direction to the point of intersection with a private road known as Rocky Creek Lane thence along the centerline of Rocky Creek Lane for approximately 1,620 feet to the point of intersection with an unnamed private drive that is the eastern boundary of Census Block 4004001034; thence following the eastern boundary of Census Block 4004001034 in a southwardly direction to a point of intersection with Cedar Plains Road (State Highway Route No. 611); thence in a northwesterly direction for about 3,500 feet along the centerline of Cedar Plains Road (State Route No. 611) to a point of intersection with Redeye Creek; thence southward along Redeye Creek until its confluence with Big Lickinghole Creek; thence in a northward direction following the course of Big Lickinghole Creek for approximately 4,000 feet to a point of intersection with an unnamed branch of Big Lickinghole Creek; thence westward following the course of the unnamed branch of Big Lickinghole Creek for about 5,400 feet; to the point of intersection with a private road known as Lake Drive; thence in a northward direction along the centerline of Lake Drive to the point of intersection with Cedar Plains Road (State Highway Route No. 611); thence westward along the centerline of Cedar Plains Road (State Route No. 611) to its point of intersection with Forest Grove Road (State Route No. 615); thence northward along the centerline of Forest Grove Road (State Route No. 615) to a point of intersection with the Dominion Virginia Power 500 KV transmission line; thence westward to a point of intersection with White Hall Creek; thence southward along the course of White Hall Creek to the confluence with Little Lickinghole Creek; thence continuing in a southward direction along the course of Little Lickinghole Creek to a point of intersection with Haskin Road (State Route No. 616), thence southward along the centerline of Haskin Road (State Highway Route No. 616) to a point of intersection with St. Paul's Church Road (State Route No. 625); thence westward along the centerline of St. Paul's Church Road (State Route No. 625) to a point of intersection with Cartersville Road (State Highway Route No. 45); thence southward along the centerline of Cartersville Road (State Highway Route No. 45) to the Goochland boundary with Cumberland County; thence westward along the Goochland boundary with Cumberland County to a point of intersection with the Goochland boundary with Fluvanna County; thence northeastwardly along the Goochland boundary with Fluvanna County to the Goochland boundary with Louisa County; thence eastwardly along the Goochland boundary with Louisa County to the point of beginning, as shown on the official electoral map of the county.~~

Commencing at a point on the Goochland boundary with Louisa County at a point of intersection with Perkinsville Road (State Highway Route No. 635); thence southwesterly along the centerline of Perkinsville Road (State Highway Route No. 635) to a point of intersection with Pony Farm Road (State Highway Route No. 702) at the northeast corner of Census Block No. 4002001011; thence continuing in a southwesterly direction following the centerline of Pony Farm Road (State Highway Route No. 702) to a point of intersection with Elpis Church Road (State Highway Route No. 636); thence following the~~

~~The election precincts of the county shall be ten (10) in number and shall be known as the Hadensville, Fife, Three Square, Sandy Hook, Goochland Courthouse 1, Goochland Courthouse 2, Centerville, Blair Road, Manakin, and central absentee voting precincts.~~

~~Sec. 2-64. Description of precincts:~~

~~(a) — *Hadensville precinct.* The description and boundaries of the Hadensville precinct shall be as follows:~~

One supervisor shall be elected from each election district.

Sec. 2-41. Precincts and polling places established.

Pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 24.2-305-24.2-310.1, 24.2-701.2, and 24.2-712, the county's election precincts are hereby created as stated in this article.

Sec. 2-42. Precinct names.

The election precincts are known as 101 (Fife), 102 (Hadensville), 201 (Three Square), 202 (Sandy Hook), 301 (Beaverdam), 302 (Randolph), 401 (Shallow Well), 402 (Centerville), 501 (Manakin), 502 (Blair), and Central Absentee Voting precincts.

Beginning at the Goochland County border with Henrico County at the point where it intersects with the northernmost point of the eastern boundary of Census Block 510754001011012; then southward on the Goochland County border with Henrico County to the intersection with the Goochland County border with Powhatan County; then westward on the Goochland County border with Powhatan County to the intersection with the eastern boundary of Census Block 510754002002046; then northward on the eastern boundary of Census Block 510754002002046 to the intersection with the southern boundary of Census Block 510754001012052; then eastward on the southern boundary of Census Block 510754001012052 to the intersection with the eastern boundary of Census Block 510754001012052 which follows an unnamed branch of the James River; then northward on the course of an unnamed branch of the James River to the intersection with Manakin Ferry Road (State Route 621); then northward on the centerline of Manakin Ferry Road (State Route 621) to the intersection with River Road West (State Route 6); then westward on the centerline of River Road West (State Route 6) to the intersection with Manakin Road (State Route 621); then northward on the centerline of Manakin Road (State Route 621) to the intersection with Snead Road (State Route 668); then northeast on the centerline of Snead Road (State Route 668) to the intersection with Hockett Road (State Route 623); then northeast on the centerline of Hockett Road (State Route 623) to the intersection with Tuckahoe Creek Parkway (State Route 740); then southeast on the centerline of Tuckahoe Creek Parkway (State Route 740) to the intersection with State Route 288 North; then southward on the centerline of State Route 288 North to the intersection with the boundary of Election District 4 at the northern boundary of Census Block 510754001011024; then northeast on the northern boundary of Census Block 510754001011024 to the point of beginning, as shown on the county's official electoral map.

K. *Central Absentee Voting Precinct*. In addition to the foregoing precincts, there is hereby established a central absentee voting precinct in the Goochland County Administration Building located at 1800 Sandy Hook Road, Goochland, Virginia, but, if the election occurs on a county holiday, then the precinct may be in the Registrar's Office, located at 1876 Sandy Hook Road, Goochland, Virginia. The central absentee voting precinct can be used for all elections.

Sec. 2-44. Polling places.

A. *Precinct 101 (Fife)*. The polling place for Precinct 101 (Fife) is Byrd Elementary School, located at 2704 Hadensville-Fife Road (State Route 606).

B. *Precinct 102 (Hadensville)*. The polling place for Precinct 102 (Hadensville) is Goochland County Fire-Rescue Station 6, located at 4810 Three Chopt Road (State Route 700).

C. *Precinct 201 (Three Square)*. The polling place for Precinct 201 (Three Square) is Chief

Cornerstone Baptist Church, located at 4481 Three Square Road (State Route 625).

D. Precinct 202 (Sandy Hook). The polling place for Precinct 202 (Sandy Hook) is the Central High Cultural and Educational Complex, located at 2748 Dogtown Road (State Route 614).

E. Precinct 301(Beaverdam). The polling place for Precinct 301 (Beaverdam) is the Goochland County Animal Shelter, located at 1900 Hidden Rock Lane (State Route 665).

F. Precinct 302 (Randolph). The polling place for Precinct 302 (Randolph) is Randolph Elementary School, located at 1552 Sheppard Town Road (State Route 639).

G. Precinct 401 (Shallow Well). The polling place for Precinct 401 (Shallow Well) is Grace Chinese Baptist Church of Richmond, located at 850 Broad Street Road (U.S. Route 250).

H. Precinct 402 (Centerville). The polling place for Precinct 402 (Centerville) is St. Matthew's United Methodist Church, located at 1706 St. Matthew's Lane (State Route 708).

I. Precinct 501 (Manakin). The polling place for Precinct 501 (Manakin) is Dover Baptist Church, located at 635 Manakin Road (State Route 621).

J. Precinct 502 (Blair). The polling place for Precinct 502 (Blair) is St. Mary's Episcopal Church, located at 12291 River Road (State Route 650).

K. Voter Satellite Office. The polling place for the Voter Satellite Office is the Parks & Recreation building at the County Complex, located at 1800 Sandy Hook Road (U.S. Route 522).

Sec. 2-45. School board election timing.

The election of school board members shall coincide with elections for the board of supervisors at the regular general election in November.

Sec. 2-46. Election of school board members.

The school board consists of five members, with one to be elected from each election district.

Sec. 2-47. School board member terms.

School board members serve for four-year terms which coincide with the board of supervisors' terms. The school board members' terms of office commence on January 1 following the member's election.

Sec. 2-48. School board member vacancies.

A vacancy in the office of a school board member shall be filled pursuant to Virginia Code §§ 24.2-226 and 24.2-227.

Sec. 2-49. Petitions for school board candidates.

In order to have their names placed on the ballot, all school board candidates shall be nominated by petition as provided by Virginia Code § 24.2-506.

Sec. 2-50. School board member ineligibility.

No employee of the school board is eligible to serve on the school board.

Secs. 2-51-2-85. Reserved.

- 3. Except as amended herein, all County Code provisions remain in effect.**
- 4. This ordinance shall be effective 30 days after adoption.**
- 5. A copy of this ordinance, including a description of the boundaries and a map showing the boundaries of the five election districts, shall be recorded in the official minutes of the Board.**
- 6. The Clerk of the Board shall send a certified copy of this ordinance, including a description of the boundaries and a map showing the boundaries of the five election districts, to the Goochland County Electoral Board, Secretary of the Commonwealth, State Board of Elections, and Division of Legislative Services.**
